

Thesis Topic Listing and Assignment Schedule for Academic Year 2023/2024

Phase 0: Familiarization with Bachelor's and Master's Theses Topics

- **From February 12, 2024, 8:00 AM until February 19, 2024, 8:00 AM**
- During this phase, Bachelor's and Master's thesis topics will be accessible in MAIS (the university system). Students are not required to register, and supervisors do not assign topics. Students are encouraged to explore the available topics. Communication between supervisors and students is anticipated.

Phase 1: Registration (Students) and Assignment (Teachers/Supervisors)

- **From February 19, 2024, 8:00 AM until February 21, 2024, 8:00 AM**, students record their topic preferences in MAIS during the first round. Supervisors do not assign topics during this phase.
- **From February 21, 2024, 8:00 AM until February 23, 2024, 8:00 AM**, supervisors assign topics to selected students. Other applicants for the same topic will be automatically rejected.
- **On February 23, 2024, at 8:00 AM**, the first round concludes. A review of topic assignments for Bachelor's and Master's theses will take place, ensuring adherence to deadlines.

Phase 2: Registration (Students) and Automatic Assignment

- **From February 26, 2024, 8:00 AM until February 28, 2024, 8:00 AM**, students who did not secure their topic in the first round can apply for the remaining available topics.
- **From February 26, 2024, 8:00 AM until February 28, 2024, 8:00 AM**, automatic topic assignments to students will occur.

After February 28, 2024, at 8:00 AM, a comprehensive review of topic occupancy and assignments for Bachelor's and Master's theses will take place. Topics are assigned to students who did not request or receive a topic in previous rounds.

This schedule outlines the structured process for thesis topic allocation, ensuring a fair and efficient selection for students in the academic year 2023/2024.
