Schedule for listing and assigning topics

for Bachelor and Master thesis in Academic year 2021/2022

The Final thesis is a compulsory part of the Bachelor and Master Degree.

Round 0 - Introduction to the topics of Bachelor and Diploma thesis

 8am on Monday 14 February 2022 to 8am on Wednesday 16 February 2022 – all topics will be visible in IS MAIS; students cannot apply for a certain topic yet, neither thesis supervisors do not assign topics.

Students will have the opportunity to get acquainted with the topics. Thesis supervisors have the opportunity to set criteria for the selection of students, in the case there are several students interested in one topic. If it is a topic "of their choice", the student can find/agree on the thesis supervisor.

1st round - Registration (students), Assigning (Thesis Supervisors)

- 8am on Wednesday 16 February 2022 to 8am on Friday 18 February 2022 students may submit their request for the Bachelor or Master thesis topics in IS MAIS. Thesis supervisors do not assign topics to students yet.
- 8am on Friday 18 February 2022 to 8am on Tuesday 22 February 2022. Thesis supervisors will assign the topics to the students that they choose
- After 8am on Tuesday 22 February 2022 each student will be able to check in IS MAIS whether he/she has been assigned a topic for Bachelor/Master thesis
 - o **If yes:** contact your Final thesis supervisor and agree on the procedure for the elaboration of the Bachelor/Master thesis as well as on the conditions for granting credits from the Bachelor/Diploma thesis seminars.
 - If not: student is waiting for the 2nd round and applies for topics that will be free in IS MAIS.

2nd round - Registration (students), Assigning (thesis supervisors)

- 8am on Wednesday 23 February 2022 to 8am on Friday 25 February 2022 students who have not been assigned a topic for Bachelor/Master thesis in the 1st round, may now apply for the remaining free topics in IS MAIS. Thesis supervisors do not assign topics.
- 8am on Friday 25 February 2022 to 8am on Tuesday 1 March 2022 the thesis supervisor will assign the topics to the selected students
- After 8am on Tuesday 1 March 2022, each participant of the 2nd round can check in IS MAIS whether he/she has been assigned a Bachelor/Master thesis topic
 - If yes: contact the thesis supervisor and agree on the procedure for the elaboration of the Bachelor/Master thesis as well as on the conditions for granting credits from the Bachelor/Diploma thesis seminars.
 - o If not: Students need to report to the Student Administration Office! The topic will be assigned to you no later than on 11 March 2022 from the remaining available topics, based on an agreement. If this does not happen, student will contact the Student Administration Office and provide information that he/she still does not have an assigned topic for the final thesis.
 - Tuesday 1 March 2022 to Friday 11 March 2022 the final check of Bachelor/Master thesis topics will be carried out. Students who didn't manage to obtain any topic in the previous rounds, will be assigned a topic that is still available.
